- COSC Grant:

## 5. **Principal Update:** *Kaylen Christiansen*

- School Development Plan 2025/26:
  - Each year, our school prepares a development plan with input from teachers, school staff, students and parents. We review many sources of data, including report cards, provincial achievement test results and school surveys. Based on this information, we create our plan identifying targeted areas for growth. Our school development plan is not meant to represent all of the work that takes place in our school, but rather it focuses on specific areas for improvement.

- Traffic and safety issues of concern Earl Grey drop off:
  - People are U-turning in front of the school, dropping kids in the middle of the road, running stop signs, speeding etc.
  - The Principal has:
    - Made a poster to send to families.
    - Asked for support from traffic safety and the CBE.
  - Ideas discussed:
    - Elbow Park has a Calming Curve. This is something that the Principal will investigate more.
    - A flexible post used to be up in the middle of the crosswalk on 8<sup>th</sup> street. This was hit last year and never replaced. This should be re-replaced.
    - Council members should write into the Calgary Police to advocate for having police surveillance.
- Spirit Days: The principal will try to get information on this out early this year, so parents feel prepared.
- Assemblies: The principal is considering increasing the opportunity for parents and the community to see students involved in performance by having more assemblies. Assembly dates are to be determined.
